## Bear Trail Record

To earn your Bear badge, you must complete twelve achievements. You must earn one for God (either achievement 1 or 2), three for Country (from achievements 3, 4, 5, 6, and 7), four for Family (from achievements 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, and 13), and four for Self (from achievements 14, 15, 16, 17, 18, 19, 20, 21, 22, 23, and 24).

Most achievements have several requirements. When you complete a requirement, draw a circle around the letter for that requirement on this page. When you have done enough requirements to complete the achievement, put an "X" in the box by the achievement.

Achievements that were not used to earn the Bear badge may be used as electives. However, note that unused parts of achievements that were used for the Bear badge may **not** be counted toward Arrow Points. Mark the letter for that requirement with an "X."

On the next page, keep a list of all of your elective credits. You earn an Arrow Point for every ten elective credits you complete.
